REGULATION

1. Organization

Leça Chess Open – Portugal 2023 tournament (from now on "The Tournament") is organized by **Grupo Desportivo Basquete de Leça - Chess Club (GDBL Chess Club)**, with the support of the following entities:, Matosinhos City Council, Matosinhos Sport, Matosinhos & Leça da Palmeira Parish Council, Portuguese Chess Federation, Porto Chess Association and Eng. Fernando Pinto de Almeida High School.

2. Schedule

Leça Chess Open – Portugal 2023 will be composed by an **OPEN** tournament and a **BLITZ** tournament, with the following schedules:

3. Place

Both tournaments will be held at Pavilhão Municipal de Leça da Palmeira (Leça da Palmeira's Sports Hall), located at Rua Margarida Ramalho, nº 61, 4450-337 Leça da Palmeira, Porto district, Portugal (<u>https://goo.gl/maps/o1GBhBrS4wzGiQ1g8</u>) – GPS coordinates: 41.2052038, -8.6948434

4. Tournament Director, Arbiters and Technical Committee

Both tournaments management and direction will be at **GDBL Chess Club** charge, with the help of **FIDE Arbiters**. The tournaments will have a **Technical Committee**, composed by 2 Tournament Directors, 2 Arbiters and the 3 first ranked tournament players, that will take care of any extraordinary issue that may arise.

5. Pairings System, Number of Rounds, Playing Time

5.1 OPEN tournament

System/Number of Rounds: the OPEN will have 9 rounds, based on the Swiss pairing

system.

<u>Playing time</u>: each player will have **90 minutes** to finish the game, with a **30 second**

increment per move, starting on move one.

Depending on the number of participants, the accelerated paring system may be applied in the first rounds.

The maximum time of waiting after the start of each session will be 30 minutes.

Any tie agreement before 30 moves is not allowed, unless accepted by the Arbiter.





5.2 BLITZ tournament

Sistem/Number of Rounds: the Blitz tournament will have 9 rounds - Swiss pairing system. Playing time: 3 minutes, with an increment of 2 seconds per move.

6. Participants

Both Tournaments are open to any chess player that loves chess. All players have to be afilliated with the Portuguese Chess Federation (PCF). The players that are not yet afilliated with the PCF may do so through the Tournament Organization, with no additional cost, sending an e-mail to **lecachessopen@gmail.com** for that purpose.

9 Tie-break criteria

For tie-break decisions, the Tournaments will be using the Portuguese Chess Federation tie-break criteria, as per its "Regulamento de Competições e Filiações 2022/2023" ("Afilliations and Competitions 2022/2023 Regulation").

10 Homologation

Both Tournaments will be approved for FIDE ELO and the **OPEN** Tournament will be a part of the Portuguese Chess Federation "**Portugal Chess Tour 2022/2023**" Classic Circuit Calendar.

11 Byes, No Show/Exclusions

Each player (excluded invited players) is allowed to a maximum of 3 byes for the entire OPEN Tournament. Each bye request has to be received by the Tournament Arbiter 24 hours before a given round, and will be valued at ½ point each for the first 5 rounds and zero points for the last 4 rounds.

Players that will not show to a given round, without any previous notice to the Tournament Direction, will be excluded from the Tournament, unless a reasonable and extraordinary reason is attended and accepted by the Tournament Direction.

14 Final notes

- a) With their registration at **Leça Chess Open Portugal 2023** Tournament, players do accept the Tournament Regulation Provisions, the FIDE and the Portuguese Chess Federation regulations.
- b) It is strictly prohibited to take any electronic device, including smartwatches, into the Tournament playing area. In the entrance hall, celular phones or any other electronic device must be delivered to the person in charge of the electronic devices reception. When leaving the playing area, each electronic device will be returned to its owner;
- c) Once the game is finished, players will have to leave the playing area, in order not to disturb the other players, or, if they want to, they can go to the <u>Game</u> <u>Analysis Room</u> next to the playing room;
- d) Players do authorize the Tournament Direction to use Tournament photos and videos where they may appear, exclusively for Tournament internet/social media communication purposes, if needed.
- e) Regarding any Tournament subject or situation that may occur and it is not described or stipulated in the present Regulation, the Tournament Direction, supported by the Technical Committee, will be the only valid entity to have the power to resolve and take decisions about them, always considering the FIDE and the Portuguese Chess Federation Regulations;





- f) The Tournament Direction reserves to itself the right to:
 Tournament players admission;
 To change the present Regulation until the Tournament Registration deadline.
