

# REGULATION

## III Terras de Trás-os-Montes Chess Open

### 1. Organization and playing hall

The tournament will take place at **Grande Hotel Dom Dinis, Avenida Nossa Senhora do Amparo, 5370-210, in Mirandela**, between 17th and 23th de August. It is co-organized by the **Municipality of Mirandela** and the **Bragança Chess Association**, with the high sponsor of **FIDE** – International Chess Federation, and **FPX – Portuguese Chess Federation**.

This tournament is also part of the Portugal Chess Tour, of the FPX, season 2021/2022.

### 2. Participants

All interested athletes who are affiliated to the FPX may participate.

Non-affiliated athletes must apply for membership in the FPX, via the organization of the present tournament.

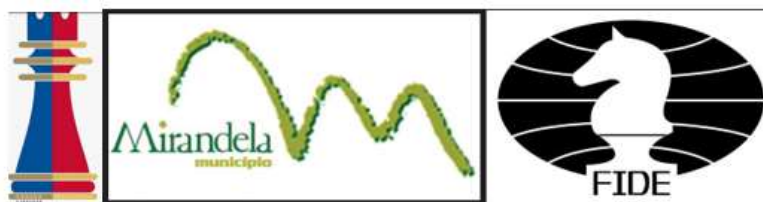

The registration fees will not be refunded after the end of the first deadline, in case of withdrawal of the athlete.

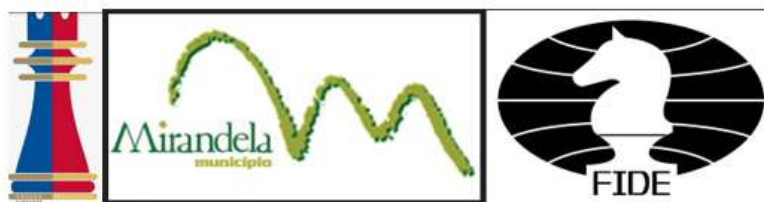

**4.2.** To be eligible for the prizes your presence at the closing ceremony is required.

## 5. Tournament system

**5.1.** Swiss system with 9 rounds. Each player will have 90 minutes to finish the game, with an increment of 30 seconds per move.

**5.2.** The maximum waiting time after the start of each session will be 30 minutes.

**5.3.** No tie agreement is allowed before 30 moves are concluded, without the arbiter's agreement.

**6.2.** At the request of the players, the organization can grant two half point byes to those who request it before the 1<sup>st</sup> session for the first 6 sessions.

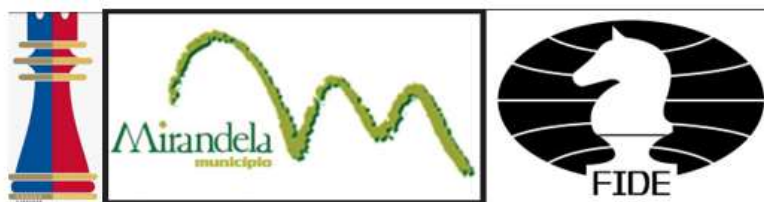
**6.3.** The maximum number of byes per player is two.

**6.4.** The organization may introduce readjustments, if they are considered imperative.

## 7. No-shows

**7.1.** The players who perform a no-show on the 1<sup>st</sup> round will be excluded from the tournament by the organization unless an exceptional situation is accepted by the tournament director.





**7.2.** Players who fail to appear once without justification accepted by the organization will be eliminated.

## **8. Tiebreaker criteria**

The tiebreaker system will be the one provided for in the FPX Competitions and Affiliations Regulation with the name "Regulamento de Competições e Filiações".

## **9. Homologation**

The tournament will be homologate to ELO FIDE and will be considered for the FPX Portugal Chess Tour.

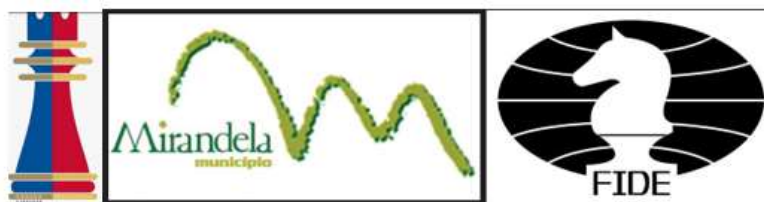

Players must appear in the game room, with clothing appropriate to the event, and have a correct and sporty behavior during the competition.

Omitted regulations will be decided by the Appeal Committee considering the FPX and FIDE Regulation.
