1. Organization / Support

1.1. The tournament is organized by the A2D Chess Club - Didáxis Academic Association, with the support of the FPX - Portuguese Chess Federation, Vila Nova de Famalicão City Council, the Didáxis Teaching Cooperative and the company Peixoto Rodrigues.

1.2. This tournament is part of the *Portugal Chess Tour 2024/2025* of the FPX and will be valid for international norms and approved for FIDE rating.

5.4. The amount to be paid is net for the Organization, so any payment expenses will be the responsibility of the payer. The participant must provide proof of payment of the fee by sending, by email, a copy of the transfer receipt to the tournament address (<u>ticfxadrez@gmail.com</u>). After receiving this receipt, the Organization will confirm the registration, which then becomes final.

5.5. The Organization reserves the right to refuse a registration. Registrations will be closed if the maximum capacity of the room is reached.

5.6. In case of cancellation of a registration already paid, the Organization will refund 100% of the amount provided that the cancellation request occurs before the end of the 1st period. Any bank charges should be borne by the player.

Registration fees will not be refunded after the end of the first deadline.

6.1. Date and time of sessions:

Closing ceremony and awards ceremony 15 minutes after the end of the last round. **Players must confirm their presence at the game venue before 19:45 on July 21**st, 2025 or they will not be paired in the 1st round.

6.2. The Organization, for reasons it considers to be force majeure, may introduce adjustments.



7. System and rate of play

7.1. Swiss system of 9 rounds. The Swiss-Manager software, approved by FIDE, will be used for pairing, tie-breaking and classification purposes.

If the tournament management deems it necessary, an accelerated system may be used in the first rounds.

7.2. Each player will have 1h30m to finish the game, with a 30s increment per move.

7.3. The tolerance/waiting time for any absences at the board, after the start of each round, will be 30 minutes.

7.4. Any agreement to a draw before 30 moves have been completed by both players is prohibited without the agreement of the arbiter.

7.5. Players (except invited players) may request a maximum of 3 half point (½) byes in the first 5 rounds and must inform the chief arbiter and the competition organization at least 24 hours before the start of the round in question (by filling the appropriate form). Bye requests for the 1st round must be made in writing, at least 24 hours before the start of the round, by email: <u>ticfxadrez@gmail.com</u>.

8. No-shows/Forfeits

8.1. Players who fail to appear in the 1st round will be eliminated from the tournament by the Organization, except in unforeseen situations accepted by the organization.

8.2. Players who fail to appear twice will be eliminated.



9. Tie-break criteria

If two or more players finish with the same number of points, the following criteria will be applied:

- **a)** Direct encounter [code 81];
- **b)** *Bucholz*, without the worst result [code 84] (0,0,1, -,-, 0);
- **c)** Buchholz [code 84] (0,0,0, -,-, 0);
- **d)** Sonneborn-Berger [code 85] (0,0,0, -,);
- e) Greater number of games [code 65];
- **f)** Highest number of wins, excluding forfeit wins [code 68] (0,-);
- g) Draw of lots

10. Restrictions

10.1. It is strictly forbidden, and without any margin of tolerance, to bring any electronic device into the playing area. At the entrance, there will be a reception where electronic devices can be left.

10.2. When a player finishes the game, becomes a spectator and must leave the game playing area so as not to disturb the other players.

10.3. It will not be permitted to analyze finished games, nor to smoke or eat in the playing area.

11.1. Other prizes will also be awarded: first-placed players by age group and first team. For the team classification, the points of the 4 best-placed players from each team are summed. In case of a tie on points, the best-placed player (from each team) will break the tie between the tied teams.

11.2. Prizes are cumulative.

11.3. To be eligible for the prizes, players need to participate in the closing session.

12. Appeal Committee

12.1. An appeal committee will be appointed, the composition of which will be announced at the start of the competition, consisting of the tournament director, two regular members and two substitutes.

12.2. Procedure: Appeals against decisions of the chief arbiter must be submitted in writing, in Portuguese or English, to the Chairman of the Appeals Committee within 30 minutes after the end of the round, accompanied by a deposit of \notin 100. This deposit will be returned to the complainant if the Appeals Committee's decision is favorable. Otherwise, it will revert to the tournament organization.



12.3. The decisions of the Appeals Committee shall not be subject to appeal.

13. Sanitary Measures

13.1. The tournament will be subject to the current health regulations of the health authority (DGS), as well as those of the FPX and FIDE, as appropriate.

13.2. At the end of a game, players must call the arbiter without leaving the table. The arbiter records the result and collects the scoresheets.

13.3. There will be no spectators in the playing area during the entire competition. Players who have finished their games must also leave the playing area.

14. Final Provisions

14.1. The Organization reserves the right of admission.

14.2. Registration and participation presuppose express acceptance of the provisions contained in these regulations; of the FPX and FIDE regulations where applicable.

14.3. Players must appear in the game room, wearing appropriate attire for the event, and behave in a correct and sporting manner during the competition.

14.4. Participants authorize the Organization to use the personal data provided, as well as photos or videos, for their dissemination on the internet and social media.

14.5. Anything not covered by these rules will be resolved by applying the FPX and FIDE rules. Any situations that still exist will be resolved by the tournament organization.

14.6. The official version of the Regulations is the Portuguese version, with the English version being a translation.
